

## Watch Time-lapse Video of New Jersey's Largest Design Build

EarthCam Technologies has presented a time-lapse video of construction at the [Newark Liberty International Airport's Terminal A](#). The \$2.7 billion project, which began in 2018, is complete. The terminal will reopen for flights on Jan. 12, according to the Port Authority. The completed project is 1 million square feet with 33 gates. The project is the largest design-build in New Jersey history, according to the airport.

The previous terminal was 50 years old and known for being largely outdated.

The new Terminal A was designed and built by Tutor Perini/Parsons, with work completed in phases to minimize customer inconvenience.
